

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
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## **WARNINGS! & SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

- 1. KEEP HANDS AND FEET CLEAR OF HIGH SPEED DIGGING BLADE.
- 2. NEVER MANUALLY ROTATE BLADE WHEN ENGINE IS IN "ON" POSITION.
- 3. ALWAYS WEAR EYE PROTECTION.
- 4. KEEP HANDS AND FEET CLEAR OF PULLEYS AND BELTS WHEN ENGINE IS RUNNING.
- 5. CLEAR TRENCHING PATH OF ANY DEBRIS OR TOOLS.
- 6. LOCATE ALL UNDERGROUND POWER, TELEPHONE, GAS AND WATER LINES BEFORE TRENCHING.
- 7. NEVER ATTEMPT TO USE THE MACHINE WITH THE GUARD/S REMOVED. BODILY HARM COULD OCCUR.
- 8. NEVER MODIFY ANY PART OF THE MACHINE TO USE FOR A PURPOSE OTHER THAN WHAT IT IS DESIGNED FOR.
- 9. DO NOT USE MACHINE FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN ITS INTENDED PURPOSE.

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. FILL CRANKCASE OF ENGINE AND CLUTCH WITH OIL. FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS OF ENGINE MANUFACTURER.
- 2. LOAD CABLE/WIRE REEL ONTO HOLDING DEVICE (1221).
- 3. PLACE THE DROP CABLE THROUGH THE CABLE GUIDE AND PULL OFF A LENGTH SUFFICIENT FOR BUILDING ENTRY. AT THE MACHINE, ANCHOR THE CABLEWIRE.



- 4. START ENGINE. (SEE ENGINE MANUAL FOR INSTRUCTIONS)
- 5. PRESS DOWN ON HANDLES SLIGHTLY TO REMOVE DOWNWARD PRESSURE ON DEPTH ADJUSTMENT PIN THEN SQUEEZE LEFT TRIGGER. AS YOU DO THIS, SQUEEZE THE RIGHT THROTTLE TRIGGER TO MAXIMUM THROTTLE. (THIS STARTS THE BLADE SPINNING SO IT WILL DIG INTO THE GROUND AS YOU LOWER THE FRONT TO OPERATION DEPTH.)
- 6. NEXT, SLOWLY LOWER THE FRONT OF THE UNIT UNTIL THE MACHINE IS LEVEL.
  RELEASE LEFT TRIGGER AND THEN PRESS DOWN SLIGHTLY ON HANDLES. THIS
  WILL ENGAGE THE DEPTH SETTING AT THE MAXIMUM DEPTH.
- 7. MAKE SURE PATH IS CLEAR AND GENTLY PULL MACHINE.

- 8 WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED TRENCHING TURN ENGINE OFF.
- 9. MOVE FRONT WHEEL CARRIAGE TO TRAVELING POSITION BY REVERSING STEP 4.

IRREGULAR OR
EXCESSIVE BELT WEAR

- 1. CHECK FOR PULLEY MISALIGNMENT.
- 2. USE OF OTHER THAN FACTORY POWER-RATED BELTS.
- 3. RATE OF DIG IS TOO FAST FOR SOIL CONDITION.

FXCESSIVE VIBRATION

- 1. LOOSE, BENT, OR BROKEN BLADE OR BIT.
- 2. LOOSE ENGINE MOUNT BOLTS.
- 3. ENGINE R.P.M. SHOULD BE 3600 R.P.M.

HOUSING CLOGGING WITH DIRT

- 1. SOIL IS TOO WET.
- BENT OR BROKEN
  DIGGING BLADE
- 2. FOREIGN OBJECT IN HOUSING.
- 1. STRIKING HARD OBJECTS, SUCH AS BRICKS, LARGE ROCKS, AND STEEL OBJECTS.

## DAMAGED OR LOST SHIPMENTS:

All shipments must be carefully inspected. In case of damaged or loss, accept the shipment, but have carrier note damages or loss on delivery receipt. If it is concealed damage, call carrier for inspection. Make claim for damage with carrier.

## LIMITED WARRANTY:

The E-Z Trencher is warranted against defects in workmanship or materials for a period of one year. Blades, bits, belts and bearings, which are normal wear items, are not warranted. This warranty covers replacement of parts only, no consequential damages are covered. In the event of a warranty claim contact E-Z Trench Manufacturing Company, Inc. This warranty does not include products which have been subject to improper use, or application, or misuse, neglect or accident; nor does it attend to products which have been repaired or altered by other than E-Z Trench Manufacturing Company, Inc. All warranty repairs are F.O.B., Loris, S.C, U.S.A. E-Z Trench Manufacturing Company, Inc. will not be responsible for any transportation charges.

## NORMAL WEAR:

Warranty will not cover repair where normal use has exhausted the life of a part. Trenchers, like all mechanical devices, need periodic parts replacement and service to perform well. It should be remembered that the service life of any trencher is dependent on the care it receives and the conditions under which it has to operate. Trenchers operate in harsh conditions, which can cause what appears to be premature wear. Such wear, when caused by rocks or other abrasive material, is not covered by warranty.


## E-Z TRENCH WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER ABUSE OR NEGLECT:

- 1. Bent or broken parts; Such damage is normally the result of abuse, such as striking a solid object with the cutting blade.
- Broken parts, which results from excessive vibration caused by loose engine mounting, loose cutting blades, unbalanced blades, improperly attaching equipment to trencher, overspeeding or abuse in operation.
- 3. Misuse, neglect, improper operation, damage or abuse.
- 4. Alteration or removal of name plates or serial numbers.
- 5. Modification or change of this product outside the factory.
